Increase in the Boarding Fees

I have been requested by the Governors of this School to inform you that with the approval of the Ministry of Education the Boarding Fees will be increased from £70. 0. 0. per annum to £85. 0. 0. per annum, as from September 1st, 1949. This will mean that the terms' fees due in advance during the School Year 1949/50 will be £85. 0. 0. instead of £70. 0. 0. as heretofore.

The increase has become necessary on account of the rise in cost of nearly all supplies of all types of equipment, of rentals and of domestic wages. It is however the intention of the Governors to make the new fees inclusive of such extras as personal laundry, its mending and provision of toilet soap, but not of such requirements as haircutting, shoe mending, suit repairing and cleaning.
