THE SCHOOL is one of the oldest in the Kingdom.

The present buildings comprise well lighted classrooms, laboratory, woodwork shop, gymnasium, assembly hall, and library. They are centrally heated.

The curriculum is based on the regulations of the Board of Education, leading to School and Higher Certificate and if desired to University scholarship.

There are facilities for games and all boys are expected to take part in school games unless medically unfit. The school is medically inspected each year.

Boys are eligible for admission by the scheme at the age of eight; but it has been found in practice advisable to raise this age to nine and a half or ten, for one year's preparatory work before entry to the full school course.

The school is not a preparatory school for other schools.

No boy can be admitted after the age of twelve unless transferring from another secondary school.

An entrance examination is obligatory on all candidates for admission.

It is a condition of entry that the parent should enter into a contract to abide by the regulations of the school and not to remove a boy from school before he reaches the age of sixteen at the earliest.

The school year begins in September and ends in July. Fees are payable in advance to the Clerk from whom a notice will be received early in each term.

Inclusive Fee £4 : 11 : 0 a term.

If a second child, boy or girl, is attending any school maintained or aided by Notts. County Council, a reduction is made for that child.

Governors' Special Places and Junior Scholarships are held at the school on the result of the County Scholarship Examination.

A Cathedral Choristership carries with it exemption from fees but entrance to the school will be regulated by examination.

School dinners are provided. The charge is 6d., but exemptions from fees by scholarship mean similar exemptions from dinner charges.

Reports on work and conduct are sent each term.

All boys are required to wear the school cap and tie. Rubber soled shoes are needed for the gymnasium and proper clothes for all games. Second-hand garments are sometimes available.

It is most important that all garments, including boots, should be clearly marked with the owner's name. The school can accept no responsibility for lost property.

The whole internal organisation, management, and discipline of the school are in the hands of the Headmaster.

The Headmaster can only be seen by appointment and interviews should be in the afternoon before 4.30.
