Dear Sir / or Madam,

I have been asked to bring to your notice the question of clothes. First of all it is most important that all your boy's clothes should be marked by Cash's name tapes; the marking ink now available does not stand up to laundry washing. The initials and surname in full are required.

Secondly. Grey stockings and underclothing, most particularly shirts, should be attended to in order that your boy may have sufficient.

Thirdly. The best suit should either be grey, or a Marlborough, or a dark suit.

Fourthly. Two pairs of shoes, one pair of house slippers, in addition to gymn shoes are needed.

Fifthly. Gum boots and overalls are needed for games in the garden, and for hobbies.

Proper equipment for games is required.

Rugger. Jersey, shorts, boots, stockings (extra pair).

Gymn. Vest, shorts, gymn shoes.

Note. Blazers are available at Griffin and Spalding, Nottingham.

Any parent who is obtaining full assistance to meet the Boarding fees, and who is unable financially to meet these requests should let me know and I will advise.

I know the clothing situation is still very difficult, but there is a very great difference between certain boys in this respect. This letter is addressed particularly to the parents of those boys who are almost inadequately supplied, and is a reminder to others to investigate matters and see that the clothing is in order.
